**RE: PAY FOR PERFORMANCE (P4P) UPDATES
Well Child Visits Periodicity Requirements**

Dear Practitioner:

IEHP has received many questions in regards to the periodicity requirements for Well Child Visits after the age of 2. This letter serves to provide some helpful tips/guidelines on issues commonly encountered when submitting for Well Child Visits reimbursement under the P4P Program.

Periodicity Requirements For Well Child Visits After Age 2.

- *IEHP pays \$45 for each Well Child Exam given from birth up to their 7th birthday and from age 12 years up to their 19th birthday.*
- *After age 2, IEHP Members are eligible for one WCV per year. IEHP pays for only one exam per each year of age within each age bracket indicated above (e.g. one WCV during the year between their 2nd and 3rd birthday period, one WCV between their 3rd and 4th birthday, etc.).*
- **There is no mandated timeframe between visits.** *For example: If Member had his 2-year WCV on August 13, 2005 and Member turns 3 on September 30, 2005, Member is eligible for his 3rd year WCV **anytime** between 09/30/2005 and 09/29/2006.*
