SUBJECT: PM160 Revision/Changes (Version 8) and Annual Well Child Visit Periodicity Requirement Changes

Dear Practitioner:

Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) is pleased to announce that the CHDP Program has released the new version 8 of the Confidential Screening/Billing Report Form (PM 160). Additionally, in our efforts to structure our P4P program with HEDIS requirements, IEHP has adjusted P4P periodicity requirements for reimbursable Well Child Visits, after the age of 2, to a **calendar** based periodicity schedule.

Below are important revisions and updates to the submission requirements to the Immunizations and Well Child Visits (WCV) components of the P4P Program:

Updates to the PM160 Form:

1. Addition of Body Mass Index (BMI) box
2. Service Location - previously titled "Provider of Service"
3. Provider Number - This field has been expanded to accommodate the 10-digit NPI number
4. Addition of Place of Service (POS) box. Enter the two-digit Place of Service code that best describes where the service was rendered
5. Diagnosis Codes - previously titled "ICD 9 Codes". PM160 now contains space for 2 ICD9 codes previously had 3

New Requirements for PM 160 submission:

1. We will calculate BMI based on the height (inches) and weight (pounds) you supply.
2. Place of Service (POS) is a required field.
3. **Effective January 1, 2008**, Blood Pressure must be recorded on Well Child Visits and Well Child Visits and Immunizations after the age of 3 years.

New Periodicity Requirements For Well Child Visits After Age 2.

1. IEHP pays \$40 for each Well Child Exam given from birth up to their 7th birthday and from age 11 years up to their 19th birthday.
2. Instead of annual Well Child Visits being reimbursed based on a birth date schedule, **we now reimburse based on calendar year** (January to December).
3. For example: If Member had his 2-year WCV on August 13, 2007 and Member turns 3 on September 30, 2007, Member is eligible for his 3rd year WCV anytime in 2008.

Furthermore, you are required to register your NPI with IEHP. We will be following up with your office if you are a P4P participant and have not registered your NPI online with IEHP.
