



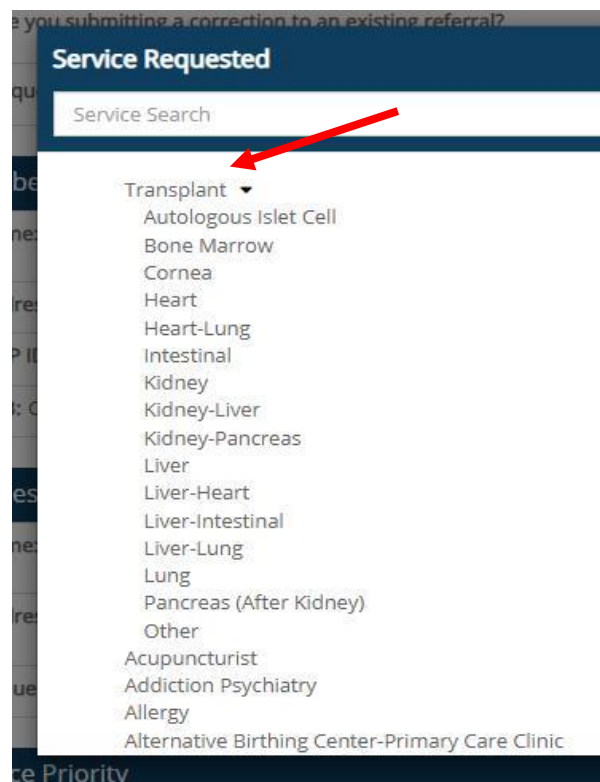
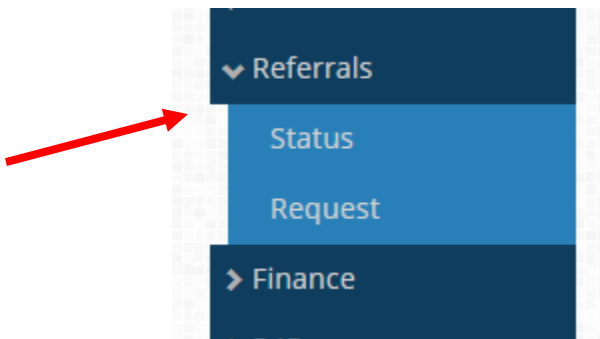

Subject: **NEW: Major Organ Transplant (MOT) Authorization Process**

Effective January 1, 2022, per DHCS All Plan Letter (APL) 21-015, **Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) will be responsible for coverage of the Major Organ Transplant (MOT) benefit** for adult and pediatric transplant recipients and donors, including related services such as organ procurement and living donor care.

MOT includes but is not limited to:

- Autologous Islet Cell
- Bone Marrow
- Cornea
- Heart
- Heart-Lung
- Intestinal
- Liver
- Liver-Heart
- Liver-Intestinal
- Liver-Lung
- Lung
- Kidney
- Kidney-Liver
- Kidney-Pancreas
- Pancreas (after kidney)

Both Direct and Delegated Providers will be able to submit MOT referrals via the secure IEHP Provider Portal:



All Providers must follow the below process regarding MOT referrals:

- The service should be requested for all IEHP Members as “Transplant” on the IEHP web portal.
- IEHP has a 72-hour turnaround time for decision of evaluation and surgery authorization
- Members will stay enrolled with IEHP throughout entire Transplant process
- MOT must be performed at a Medi-Cal approved Center of Excellence (COE)
- Pediatric transplants will be performed at a California Children Services (CCS) approved facility
- All Transplants MUST be authorized by IEHP
