**Subject:** Participation Required in CAIR2 for  
 2022 Global Quality P4P Program

IEHP would like to thank you for participating in the **2022 Global Quality P4P (GQ P4P) Program**. One of the participation requirements for this program year is to be connected to the **California Immunization Registry (CAIR2)**.

Providers are expected to be connected to CAIR2 and **demonstrate entry** of immunizations in the registry **no later than July 1, 2022**. IEHP will confirm Provider connectivity through patient records in the CAIR2 system.

**Providers who do not have immunization records entered into CAIR2 by July 1, 2022, will no longer be eligible to receive incentive dollars from the GQ P4P Program.** Note: Providers who have previously connected and are submitting to CAIR2 Registry do not have to re-register with CAIR.

#### Why is CAIR2 Participation a Requirement for 2022 GQ P4P?

- All Providers must utilize CAIR2 for patient immunizations tracking. CAIR2 is key to centralizing patient immunization records, allowing all immunizations records to be accessible to Providers during patient care.
- DHCS is also adding this requirement for all Primary Care Providers as part of the Facility Site Review (FSR) Audits as noted in the All-Plan Letter (APL) 20-006.

#### How will We Know If Our Practice/Physician Has Met the Participation Requirement?

IEHP will continue to send out monthly interim reports to show updated data on Provider performance relating to the 2022 GQ measures. **There will be a CAIR2 participation status indicator added to the 2022 monthly interim reports, acknowledging that IEHP can see new immunizations submitted into CAIR2 by the Provider.** Your office should start receiving the 2022 GQ P4P interim reports beginning March 2022.
