Subject: **Free At-Home COVID-19 Test Kits Available**

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has announced that as of January 19, 2022, COVID-19 at home test kits are being made available in two ways:

1. Free At-Home Test Kits Available Via Mail

Anyone with a U.S. residential address can request COVID-19 tests to be delivered directly to their home through a new federal government website: www.covidtests.gov. DHCS encourages all Californians to take advantage of this opportunity. There is currently a limit of **four** (4) at-home tests per household.

To place an order, provide your name and residential address; no other identification, credit card, or health insurance information is required. These tests will be delivered in the mail through the U.S. Postal Service. According to the federal government, tests will typically ship within 7-12 days after ordering.

2. Medi-Cal to Cover At-Home COVID-19 Tests Obtained at Pharmacies

Starting February 1, Medi-Cal will begin covering at-home COVID-19 tests obtained at pharmacies enrolled as Medi-Cal providers. Coverage will be billed and reimbursed as a pharmacy-billed medical supply benefit through Medi-Cal Rx, the state's fee-for-service prescription drug system for Medi-Cal. Providers do not need to submit a prescription for Members.

Reimbursement for at-home test kits previously purchased

For all at-home test kits purchased between March 11, 2021, and January 31, 2022, DHCS will reimburse beneficiaries the retail cost with a receipt, using the process outlined [here](#) or :
