## Do you care for IEHP Members with severe chronic conditions?

What is CCM?	<ul> <li>A program that addresses whole person care</li> <li>Assists Members with medical, behavioral, and social determinants of health (SDoH) needs.</li> <li>Supports Members, caregivers and families in coordinating care and services</li> </ul>
Conditions managed in the CCM program:	<ul> <li>Chronic homelessness - impairing the ability to function in the community</li> <li>Serious illnesses impacting Members' Activities of Daily Living including:         <ul> <li>Advanced liver disease</li> <li>Cancer</li> <li>Decompensating neurological conditions</li> <li>New cerebral vascular accident</li> <li>Trauma (current)</li> <li>Chronic physical condition and/or behavioral health symptoms</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Members are referred to the CCM program through:	<ul> <li>Medical Management program referrals via IEHP</li> <li>Discharge planner referrals</li> <li>Member, Caregiver, or Provider referrals</li> </ul>
