Subject: **REMINDER: 2023 Global Quality P4P Program – CAIR2 PCP Participation Requirement**

Thank you for participating in the **2023 Global Quality P4P (GQ P4P) Program**. We are looking forward to another year of partnership to ensure our Members receive the quality preventive services necessary to support vibrant health.

REMINDER: It is required that PCPs must be connected to CAIR2 and **demonstrate entry** of immunizations into the registry, **no later than July 1, 2023**. IEHP will confirm PCP connectivity through patient records in the CAIR2 system.

PCPs who are not connected and do not have immunization records entered in CAIR2 by July 1, 2023, will not be eligible to receive incentive dollars from the GQ P4P Program. No further action is required for PCPs already connected and entering immunization records.

Why is CAIR2 Participation a Requirement for 2023 GQ P4P?

- All Providers must utilize CAIR2 for patient immunization tracking as it is foundational in centralizing patient immunization records, allowing Providers to access all immunization records during patient care.
- DHCS has included this requirement for all Primary Care Providers as part of the Facility Site Review (FSR) Audit, as noted in the All-Plan Letter (APL 20-006).

PCP CAIR2 Connectivity Status:

- IEHP will send you a list of your contracted PCPs' CAIR2 participation status by February 28, 2023.
- IEHP will continue to monitor all PCPs' CAIR2 utilization through July 1, 2023.
- PCPs will be able to find their CAIR2 participation status on their monthly 2023 GQ P4P interim report **beginning in March 2023**.
